III. READING AND APPROVAL OF MINUTES FOR AUGUST 22, 2024:

Chairman Hughes asked if there was a motion for the August minutes. Dean Kelley made a motion to approve. Chad Bomar seconded the motion to approve. The vote was unanimous. Motion to approve carried.

IV. NEW BUSINESS:

- 1. Pie Slingers 50C Fieldstone Commons Rock Spring:** The Board reviewed the application for the new owner of Pie Slingers. The Board asked what licenses she would be requesting, and she said the same as the previous owner. Chairman Hughes asked Mrs. Testa about the name being Pie Slingers LLC doing business as The Grindstone Tavern and if she would consider having it Pie Slingers/The Grindstone Tavern because sometimes the state will not want the name with an LLC in it and she said yes she could do that. There was also discussion on the two buildings adding a cover over the patio part making it all under one roof. Chairman Hughes asked if there was a motion. Dean Kelly made a motion to approve. Chad Bomar seconded he motion. The vote was unanimous. Motion to approve carried.

2. **Uncorked Wine & Spirits 921 LaFayette Road Rossville:** The Board reviewed the application to add a sample license to the existing off premise spirits license from Kevin Richardson owner of the store Uncorked Wine & Spirits. Chairman Hughes asked if there was a motion. Chad Bomar made a motion to approve. Dean Kelley seconded the motion. The vote was unanimous. Motion to approve carried.

VI. OPEN DISCUSSION:

The owners of a new campground named Blue Moon Campground located on Old Mineral Springs Road in LaFayette inquired about having a retail malt/wine license for their property. The owner Ray Henderson stated that the campground would be a twenty-one year or older member only gated campground, and they would like to have a retail store on the property so the members could buy snacks, food or alcoholic beverages while camping but would like for it to sit more toward the middle of the property. The Board stated that the ordinance states that any retail store such as this is required to be visible from the road. They stated that there was another location asking about doing the same thing and the county would have to amend the ordinance to allow this.
