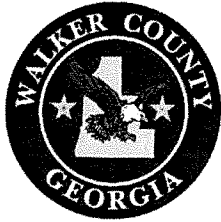

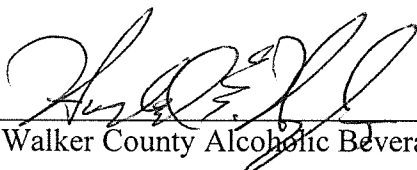
IV. OPEN DISCUSSION:

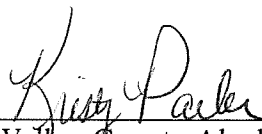
V. ADJOURNMENT:
