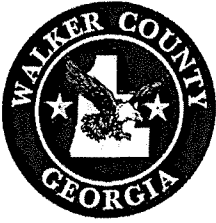

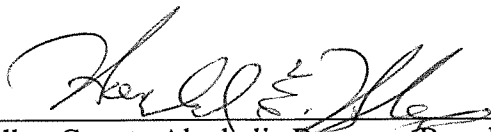
IV. ADJOURNMENT:

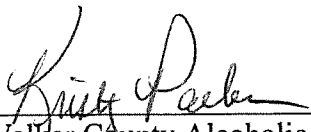
V. OPEN DISCUSSION:
