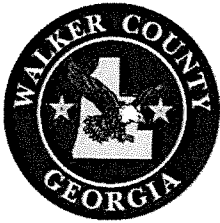

II. READING AND APPROVAL OF MINUTES FOR SEPTEMBER 23, 2021

Dean Kelley seconded the motion. Vote was unanimous. Motion to send a letter carried. Mr. Watts thanked the Board for their time.

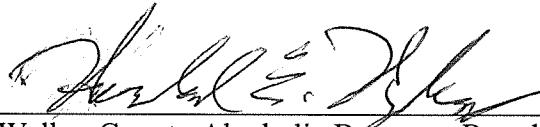
IV. OPEN DISCUSSION:
